## 1. Aegrotat Awards

- 1.1 Undergraduate awards
  - 1.1.1 A student prevented by illness or other good cause from taking either the whole or part of the assessments required for the final Stage of a course of study may thereupon be treated by the Senate, on the recommendation of the Faculty Board and subject to such conditions as are prescribed in the Regulations, as a successful student in those assessments and be granted an Aegrotat award.
  - 1.1.2 An Aegrotat degree shall not be granted as a Degree with Honours or with a Pass at Honours, an Ordinary Degree or an Advanced Degree of Master.
  - 1.1.3 An Aegrotat award shall not be granted with Merit or Distinction.
- 1.2 Postgraduate taught courses
  - 1.2.1 A student prevented by illness or other good cause from taking either the whole or part of the assessments for a course of study may thereupon be treated by the Senate, on the recommendation of the Faculty Board and subject to such conditions as are prescribed in the Regulations, as a successful student in those assessments and be granted an Aegrotat award.
  - 1.2.2 An Aegrotat award shall not be granted with Merit or Distinction.
